#### **Biographical Sketch**

Benjamin Gettler was born on September 16, 1925 in Louisville, Kentucky to Herbert and Gertrude Cohen Gettler. His parents were both born in pre-Mandate Palestine and immigrated to the United States in the 1920's.

Gettler studied economics at the University of Cincinnati and attended Harvard Law School. He was a partner with the law firms of Brown & Gettler and Gettler, Katz, & Buckley where he practiced labor law. He was a key figure in the development of Cincinnati's public transportation system and later served on the board of the Southwest Ohio Regional Transit Authority from 2003 to 2006. He also was a member of the Board of Trustees of the University of Cincinnati from 1993 to 2002 and chairman of the Board and president of the shoe and rubber manufacturing company, Vulcan Corporation.

Gettler was an active participant in national Jewish affairs and the local Cincinnati Jewish community. He was chairman of Bonds for Israel of Cincinnati in 1969. He was a member of the American Israel Public Affairs Committee (AIPAC) where he supported foreign aid assistance to Israel. In 1985, Gettler aided in the creation of the National Jewish Coalition (later renamed the Republican Jewish Coalition) in support of Ronald Reagan's presidential campaign.

Gettler was involved with the Jewish Community Relations Council of Cincinnati (JCRC) in which he served as board member beginning in 1971 and served as president beginning in 1978. He fought against antisemitism and advocated for Jewish interests with local and national political leaders. He was one of the initial trustees of the Rockwern Charitable Foundation which granted money to Yavneh Day School (Rockwern Academy), Cedar Village, local synagogues, and other Jewish community organizations. In addition, Gettler was a key figure in the establishment of The Jewish Foundation of Cincinnati in 1995. Among the organizations and activities the Foundation funded were missions to Israel for Jewish teens; Camp Livingston; Yavneh Day School; Cincinnati Hebrew Day School; Cedar Village; Hebrew Union College-Jewish Institute of Religion; and the Jewish Community Relations Council of Cincinnati. Gettler was appointed to the Board of Trustees at the University of Cincinnati in 1994, eventually becoming Chairman of the Board and serving until 2003.

Toward the end of 1990, Gettler became active with the Jewish Institute for National Security Affairs (JINSA), becoming chairman of the board in 1994, and later chairman of the Resolutions and Policy Committee. He oversaw the publication of JINSA reports, traveled to various countries on strategic diplomatic missions, and was influential in matters concerning the Anti-Ballistic Missile Treaty and nuclear weapons. After he retired from the Resolutions and Policy Committee in 1998, he continued participating in diplomatic trips with the organization. He remained actively involved with JINSA until his death in 2013.

Gettler was a key figure in the operation of The Jewish Hospital of Cincinnati. He was a trustee and later chairman of the hospital from 1978 to 1992; chairman of the Midwest Hospital Systems, Inc. from 1987 to 1990 and from 1992 to 1993; and trustee of the Health Alliance of Greater Cincinnati from 1995 to 1996 and then again in 2000 to 2003. He facilitated the 1994 merger of The Jewish Hospital and the Health Alliance of Greater Cincinnati, and the sale of The Jewish Hospital in 2010. He helped negotiate the establishment of the Jewish Foundation using funds generated from The Jewish Hospital in 1995 to support the local Jewish community. During his role as president and chairman of the Foundation, he worked with the University of Cincinnati to endow a Judaic Studies Chair in 1998 and provided funds for teenagers to visit Israel. He retired from the board in 2012.

Benjamin Gettler had four children: Jorian, Thomas, Gail, and Benjamin. He married Deliaan (Dee) Angel on March 3, 1972. Gettler passed away on June 4, 2013.
