Biographical Sketch Adolphe Danziger De Castro was born in Poland in 1866 and emigrated to the United States in 1883. He was an author, poet, editor and an active supporter of Theodore Roosevelt and Republican politics. He also was also known by the name Adolphe Danziger.

Scope and Content Collection contains correspondence with Louis D. Brandeis, Dwight D. Eisenhower, Herbert Hoover, Theodore Roosevelt, and Adlai Stevenson as well as others. Miscellaneous writings, manuscripts, poetry, awards, and photographs are included.
