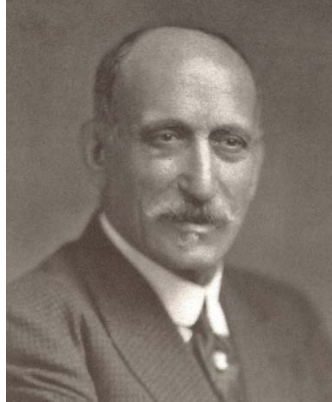

Biographical Sketch	Lazard Kahn (1850-1928) emigrated to the U.S. in 1866. He was a stove manufacturer and inventor; resident of Hamilton, Ohio.
Scope and Content	Correspondence, letterbooks, and contracts concerning Kahn's career as a manufacturer of stoves; diaries from his European travels; and genealogical materials concerning the Kahn-Jacob Lemann families.
