Biographical Sketch	George Alexander Kohut was born in Hungary in 1874. After becoming a rabbi in 1897 Kohut spent the bulk of his career as an educator, involving himself in educational and cultural interests. In 1915 Kohut established the Alexander Kohut Memorial Foundation in honor of his father to aid and assist the work of students and scholars. George Alexander Kohut died in 1933.
