Biographical Sketch	Jonas Phillips was born in Germany in 1736. Phillips was a merchant, patriot, and patriarch of the Phillips
	family in America. Phillips was a founder of Congregation Mickve Israel, Philadelphia, and served in the
	Philadelphia militia during the Revolutionary War. Phillips married Rebecca Mendez Machado, with whom he had twenty-one children. Phillips died in 1803.
