CONSTITUTIONS AND BY-LAWS
of the
AISS SHATIM OF MONTGOMERY, ALABAMA.

ARTICLE I.
NAME AND PRINCIPAL OFFICE.
1. The name of said corporation is AISS SHATIM OF MONTGOMERY, ALABAMA.
2. The principal office under its charter will be Montgomery, Montgomery County, Alabama, but it may maintain branch offices elsewhere as the Board of Directors may designate.

ARTICLE II.
CONSTITUTION.
The Charter of said corporation as granted by the Probate Court of Montgomery County, Alabama, shall be its Constitution.

ARTICLE III.
PURPOSE.
This corporation shall not have any capital stock, and shall not be conducted for the purpose of pecuniary gain.

ARTICLE IV.
MEMBERSHIP.
1. Participation in the activities of the Society shall be by membership, each member as hereinafter described, being entitled to one vote, either in person or by proxy, on all questions pertaining to the affairs of said corporation, arising at any regular or special meeting of the members of the Society.
2. Membership shall be Annual.
(a) An Annual Member being one who contributes six dollars in any one year towards the support and maintenance of the Society, and such member shall be entitled to a vote at all meetings of the Society for the year which such member makes the contribution.

ARTICLE V.
MEETINGS.
(a) The annual meeting of the Society shall be held at such time and place as the Executive Committee shall determine. Special meetings shall be called at any time by the President or at the request of the Executive Committee.
(b) Five members present in person at any meeting of the Society shall constitute a quorum.
(c) Notice of any regular or call meeting of the Society shall be by card or personal notice to the discretion of the Executive Committee, at least ten days before such meeting.
