CERTIFICATE OF INCORPORATION
of
THE JUDAH L. MAGNES FOUNDATION, INC.
(Pursuant to Article 2 of the Membership Corporation Law)

We, the undersigned, desiring to form a membership corporation for the purposes hereinafter set forth, do hereby make, subscribe, acknowledge and file this Certificate of Incorporation pursuant to the provisions of Article 2 of the Membership Corporation Law of the State of New York.

1. The name of the proposed corporation is THE JUDAH L. MAGNES FOUNDATION, INC.

2. The purposes for which it is to be formed are as follows:

(a) To acquire, by gift, devise or otherwise, money or property of every kind, nature and description; to administer and use the same and the income and proceeds thereof or either exclusively for religious, charitable, scientific, literary or educational purposes.

(b) To stimulate and further the education of citizens of the United States of America and other peoples in the world to the necessity and desirability of promoting good will and mutual cooperation between peoples of various races, creeds, cultures and political views, including as a means to that end research and publication of periodicals, pamphlets and essays and the contribution of funds to other organizations with similar ends and purposes and to do all other things deemed appropriate to perpetuate the principles heretofore expounded by the late Judah L. Magnes.

(c) The corporate purposes shall not include, nor shall the corporation have power to attempt to influence legislation by propaganda or by any other means.
