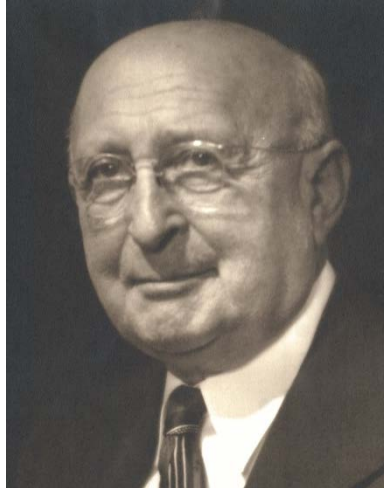

Biographical Sketch	Jacob H. Kaplan was born in Germany in 1874. In 1901 he received a B.A. from the University of Cincinnati and in 1902 was ordained as a rabbi at Hebrew Union College in Cincinnati. In 1906 Kaplan earned a Ph.D. from the University of Denver. From 1926 until his retirement Kaplan served as a congregational rabbi at Temple Israel in Miami, Florida.
