Biographical Sketch	Jacob Z. Lauterbach was born in Galicia in 1873. He received his rabbinic ordination and a Ph.D. while in Berlin, Germany. In 1911 he became a professor of Talmud at Hebrew Union College in Cincinnati. Lauterbach was a Talmudic scholar and served on many scholarly and academic boards. Jacob Z. Lauterbach died in 1942.
Scope and Content	Collection consisting of correspondence, writings, notes, awards, and miscellaneous materials relating to Lauterbach's career as a rabbi, Talmudic scholar, and faculty member at Hebrew Union College.
