Biographical Sketch	Ephraim Frisch was born in Lithuania in 1880. In 1904 he was ordained as a rabbi at Hebrew Union College in Cincinnati. Frisch was a pulpit rabbi and was active in the Central Conference of American Rabbis, the American Civil Liberties Union and Americans for Democratic Action. Ephraim Frisch died in 1957.
Scope and Content	Collection consisting of correspondence, sermons, writings, biographical data, newspaper clippings, prayers, memorials, and notes; together with a denominational survey of Christian education.
