**Biographical Sketch** Joseph Stolz was born in Syracuse, N.Y. in 1861. In 1884 he was ordained as a rabbi at Hebrew Union

College in Cincinnati. Stolz spent most of his career in Chicago at Zion Congregation, and later, at Temple Isaiah. Stolz was president of the Central Conference of American Rabbis from 1905-1907. Stolz died in

1941.

**Scope and Content** Collection consisting of correspondence, sermons, writings and notebooks concerning congregational

activities and Stolz's work in the Central Conference of American Rabbis; together with letters of family

members in Germany.
