Biographical Sketch	Born in Berlin, Lewy was educated and taught in Germany until the Nazi period. He then came to Cincinnati, joining the faculty of Hebrew Union College-Jewish Institute of Religion. Lewy was a philologist and Assyriologist. Lewy died in Cincinnati in 1963.
Scope and Content	Collection consisting of correspondence, primarily with his parents, covering early teaching career and Army tenure; together with photographs, notes, and correspondence of his wife, Hildegard.
Terms of Access	The collection is open for use; no restrictions apply.
