B. Benedict Glazer was born in Dallas, Texas, on August 18, 1902. He received his BA and MA

degrees from the University of Cincinnati and was ordained a rabbi at Hebrew Union College. Glazer was a noted Reform rabbi in New York City and Detroit, Michigan. He served on the governor's Commission on Civil Rights in Michigan, and was on the Executive Council of the

Union of American Hebrew Congregations. He died in Detroit, May 15, 1952.
