Biographical Sketch Adolf Guttmacher was born in Germany on January, 7, 1861 and immigrated to the US in

1884. He was ordained a rabbi at Hebrew Union College and received a Ph.D. from Johns Hopkins University. Guttmacher served congregations in Baltimore. He died on January 17,

1915 in Baltimore.
