Administrative Information

Biographical Sketch	David Polish was born in Cleveland in 1910. He graduated from the University of Cincinnati in 1931 and was ordained as a rabbi at Hebrew Union College in Cincinnati in 1934.
	Rabbi Polish was president of the Central Conference of American Rabbis the organizational arm of the Reform rabbinate in the U.S from 1971-1973. He helped plan the organization's first meeting in Jerusalem in 1970 and, under his leadership, the CCAR became a member of the World Jewish Organization.
	Polish was a congregational rabbi who spent most of his career in the Chicago area. After a stint as director of the Hillel Foundation at Cornell University and serving five years at a congregation in Waterbury, Connecticut, Polish came to Chicago in 1947. He was founding rabbi of Beth Emet The Free Synagogue in Evanston and served as its rabbi from 1950 until his retirement in 1980.
	Polish was a prolific author and a devoted Zionist. He was a leader in the American Reform movement and received numerous honors and awards during his lifetime.
	Polish was married to Aviva Friedland for 57 years. They had two children: Judith Shenker and Daniel.
	David Polish died in Evanston, Illinois on April 16, 1995 at the age of 85.
Scope and Content	Collection consisting of correspondence (bulk 1992-1995), sermons, and writings. Includes correspondence with Stephen S. Wise and Abba Hillel Silver; sermons and other writings; and miscellaneous items, including a journal of a trip to Palestine in 1936 and materials pertaining to his student years at Hebrew Union College.
Arrangement	The collection is divided in two (2) series: A. Correspondence; B. Sermons and Writings.
Terms of Access	The collection is open for use; no restrictions apply.

Scope and Content Note Consists primarily of a large file of letters and other materials compiled in chronological order by Rabbi Polish from March 1992 until his death in 1995. This file is maintained here as it was created by Rabbi Polish and contains information on Polish's work, interests and activities during the last years of his life.

Also included in this series are files from earlier in Polish's life. These include materials on Temple Mizpah of Chicago and Beth Emet The Free Synagogue in Evanston, Illinois; files from Polish's student years at Hebrew Union College in Cincinnati; files, including a diary, of trips to Palestine in 1936 and Israel in 1959; and correspondence files with Abba Hillel Silver and Stephen S. Wise.
