Administrative Information

Biographical Sketch Following World War II, a few congregational and HUC-JIR rabbis met to form the Greater Cincinnati Board of Rabbis. Their goal was to "stress the primacy of religion in the personal and communal life of a Jew." The Board also strives to provide leadership for the Jewish community and strengthen and dignify the status of being a rabbi in Cincinnati.

The Board meets monthly from September-June and elects a new board every year at an end-of-the-year Kallah. At the Kallah, outside speakers are brought in to educate the members on a variety of topics.

The Greater Cincinnati Board of Rabbis frequently speaks out on local, national and international social issues. They are a member of the Hunger Task Force and actively involved with the Metropolitan Area Religious Coalition of Cincinnati.

Scope and Content Records consist of agendas, minutes, constitutions, presidential correspondence, membership lists, and publicity.
