### **Biographical Sketch**

Following World War II, a few congregational and HUC-JIR rabbis met to form the Greater Cincinnati Board of Rabbis. Their goal was to "stress the primacy of religion in the personal and communal life of a Jew." The Board also strives to provide leadership for the Jewish community and strengthen and dignify the status of being a rabbi in Cincinnati.

The Board meets monthly from September-June and elects a new board every year at an end-of-theyear Kallah. At the Kallah, outside speakers are brought in to educate the members on a variety of topics.

The Greater Cincinnati Board of Rabbis frequently speaks out on local, national and international social issues. They are a member of the Hunger Task Force and actively involved with the Metropolitan Area Religious Coalition of Cincinnati.

Records consist of agendas, minutes, constitutions, presidential correspondence, membership lists,

and publicity.
