Biographical Sketch	Born in Philadelphia, January 5, 1870, Isaac Bacharach was a businessman and banker who pursued a political career as a Republican in New Jersey. After serving on the Atlantic City Council (1907-1911), he was elected to the State Assembly (1913) and the US Congress (1915). He served in Congress until 1936. Bacharach died in Atlantic City in 1956.
Scope and Content	Consists mainly of scrapbooks containing newspaper clippings relating to Bacharach's career as a Congressman from New Jersey (1915-1937). Also included are testimonials, photographs, and miscellaneous materials.
Terms of Access	The collection is open for use; no restrictions apply.
