

**Biographical Sketch** Samuel N. Pike was born in New York City in 1822. Pike was a businessman who funded the building of Pike's Opera House in Cincinnati in 1857. In 1846 he married Nettie Miller of Cincinnati. Samuel N. Pike died in 1872.

**Scope and Content** Papers of Samuel and Nettie Pike, including a scrapbook and biographical sketch of Samuel Pike; together with a memory book and German-English lessons of Nettie Pike.
