Biographical Sketch	Born in Hungary in 1830, Huebsch came to the U.S. in 1866. Huebsch was a rabbi and a scholar, publishing many works on Hebrew texts and manuscripts. Huebsch died in 1884.
Scope and Content	Collection consisting of notes on rabbinic literature, sermons, book reviews, prayers, poetry, notes, and correspondence; together with materials concerning Huebsch's rabbinical activities in Europe.
