#### **Administrative Information**

Biographical Sketch Gerson B. Levi was born in Scotland in 1878. He was educated at the University of Pennsylvania,

receiving his doctorate there in 1910. Although ordained by the Jewish Theological Seminary of America, Levi became a proponent of Reform Judaism and was mentored by Emil G. Hirsch. Spending the bulk of his career in Chicago after a short stint in Helena, Arkansas, Levi was active in many Reform organizations and was the editor of the Reform Advocate. He was the author of several books

and was involved in Chicago communal affairs.

**Scope and Content** The collection consists mostly of sermons. There is also a folder of correspondence and a

miscellaneous file of writings and clippings.

**Arrangement** This collection is arranged in one (1) series: A. General.
