## Administrative Information

**Biographical Sketch** Hyman Horowitz was born in Bialystok, Poland on November 15, 1895. He immigrated to the United States in 1921 at the age of 28. Horowitz graduated from John Marshall Law School in Cleveland, Ohio in 1928. He was an attorney for the Home Owners Loan Corporation (agency of the federal government) from 1934-1941. From 1942-1952, he was Cleveland's assistant law director during the administration of Mayor Frank Lausche. He then served as a police prosecutor until his retirement in 1966. In addition to practicing law, he was an avid Hebrew scholar, writer, and editor.

Horowitz was editor of the Cleveland Jewish World, a Yiddish daily newspaper from 1938-1952. He wrote for the Cleveland Plain Dealer on Israel and the Middle East from 1944-1960, and also wrote for the Jewish Morning Journal of New York City from 1921-1938.

Horowitz was a member of the Board of Trustees of the Cleveland Jewish Community Federation and served as an executive board member of the Cleveland Zionist Society. He died on February 21, 1969.

**Scope and Content** This collection consists of writings, including articles, speeches, and manuscripts, in English and Yiddish, by Hyman Horowitz, along with some personal correspondence. Included are articles for the Cleveland Jewish World, the Cleveland Plain Dealer, the Jewish Morning Journal of New York City, and various other Jewish periodicals. The majority of the articles are categorized by subject with a few miscellaneous articles categorized by publisher. Also included are three unpublished manuscripts: Force of Destiny, Three Worlds, and Rebirth of a Nation.

**Arrangement** This collection is arranged in one (1) series: A. General.

**Terms of Access** The collection is open for use; no restrictions apply.
